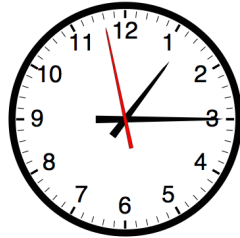

Dislocated Worker Training Funds Available to Businesses!!

Do you have to deal with the high cost of training your NEW workers?

The FMS Workforce Career Centers have recently been awarded a Dislocated Workers Training Grant. The **TET—DW** (Trade and Economic Transitions-Dislocated Worker Training Grant), is available to businesses and can assist in cutting training costs of new employees. A business can save up to \$3000 per trainee (50% of the gross wage training costs) during the training period when hiring and training a Dislocated Worker. Eligible trainees must be Dislocated Workers who are collecting or have exhausted Unemployment Insurance Benefits and are not **fully** qualified with the necessary skills for the position. The goal of the program is to assist businesses in reducing training costs and assist unemployed workers in obtaining full time employment with valuable hands-on skills training.

OJT is training and related supervision for a new employee at the work place while the employee is paid to perform the actual job. OJT accelerates the employee's proficiency in the knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to satisfactorily perform the job. Training a new employee can be a significant and costly undertaking.
